### Sponsorship and Marketing Manager

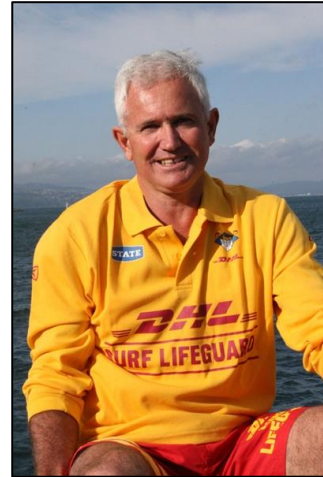
