Course Overview

The Surf Officials Level Two course provides an advanced programme for current surf officials who are keen to further develop their knowledge and skills and perform senior roles at surf lifesaving events.

The course builds on the skills and knowledge obtained in the Level One course with a focus on decision making and problem solving skills. The Surf Officials Level Two course is the second formal stage of the Surf Life Saving New Zealand Surf Officials pathway. Officials interested in further developing their skills can progress into various event roles and take future development workshops and informal learning opportunities offered by Surf Life Saving New Zealand.

Course Duration	Two days
Course Facilitator(s)	All SLSNZ courses are delivered by approved facilitators
Who should attend	Surf Life Saving Club members that are existing officials who have completed the Level One course and are interested in further developing their skills and surf officiating progression.
Participant requirements	To successfully complete the Surf Officials Level Two course participants need to attend the full course and participate in its activities and successfully complete and submit to SLSNZ the post course practical assessment.

4. People management
5. Specific officials roles

2. Identify conflict avoidance strategies
3. Identify the risk assessment process
4. Manage pre event preparation
5. Perform a selected surf officials role
6. Contribute to event planning
7. Lead a team of officials
